CLASSROOM GUIDELINES

GRADING

Your grade in this class will be based on the following breakdown for each QUARTER:

★ 80% TEST GRADES

★ 20% HOMEWORK

- Unit Assessments (similar to a big quiz) = 1 TEST GRADE EACH
- Quarter Assessments = 2 TEST GRADES

- Expect a small amount of homework every day. If you use your class time efficiently, most days you will be able to finish your work in class.
- Homework is to be completed on your iPad and submitted on your iPad.
- Homework should be done neatly and **all work must be shown to receive full credit.**
- Homework will be graded for effort or selected problems may be graded for accuracy.
- Homework turned in late will receive half credit and will only be accepted until the end of the unit from which it was assigned.

GETTING HELP

If you are struggling with any of the material **do not** hesitate to come and see me! Don't wait and think it will just get better. You will get behind very quickly! There are a number of options we have to help you be successful in this class!

- I am available during 3rd and 6th hours to help students.
- SSC - Room 191 - The Student Success Center is open every hour of the school day and is staffed with various teachers throughout the day. The SSC is also open before and after school on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday (AM only). **I AM IN THERE THE 2ND HALF OF 6TH HOUR!**
- Math Lab - Room 360 - This room is for math help only. It is staffed with 2 math TA's each period of the day (no before/after school help).
